EDMONTON, **AB**, **February 27**, **2018** – The Edmonton Public Library (EPL) is now a bigger and better neighbour in the Calder community.

Join us for the Grand Opening Celebration of our new Calder Branch. The 10,000 square foot standalone facility – almost double the size of the previous location – opened at 127 Street and 131 Avenue on January 31, 2018. We have been serving the Calder community since 1966, and the new library will meet growing demands for study and community space, as well as our customers' desire for more room to play, create and explore.

Designed by Atelier Tag and The Marc Boutin Architectural Collaborative, the new Calder Branch reflects the area's historic ties to the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, targets LEED Silver certification, and features a large mosaic mural of custom-cut glass tiles.
