### Call for Submissions Capital City Press Anthology

Capital City Press is calling for submissions for the inaugural issue of the Capital City Press Anthology in 3 categories: Fiction, Non-Fiction, and Poetry. The CCP Anthology will be published online, and writers will receive an honorarium of \$25 per published work. **Submissions are open until December 15, 2020.** 

#### Please read through the following guidelines before sending us your work:

• Capital City Press, with the Edmonton Public Library, is committed to providing a platform for diverse voices and experiences. We encourage new writers, women, people of colour, Indigenous, LGBTQ+ individuals, and others from under-represented, marginalized communities to submit their works and perspectives to the CCP Anthology.

• At this time, our editorial board is only prepared to accept English submissions for the CCP Anthology. We are aware that this is a shortcoming and will work towards featuring guest editors to help us with non-English submissions in future publications. When we gain more language capacity on our editorial team, we will update this call for submissions.

• The writer should reside in the Greater Edmonton Area; or is a member of the Alexander First Nations, the Enoch Cree First Nations, or the Paul First Nations; or the written work is about the Greater Edmonton Area.

• Reprints will be accepted for submission, but please indicate that it is a reprint and that you are the copyright holder of the work.

#### How to Format Your Work:

- All submissions should be typed, 12 pt. Times New Roman.
- If your submission is longer than one page, please paginate your work.
- Poetry
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Visual and concrete poetry must be submitted as a PDF. All other poetry can be submitted as .doc or .docx file.
- Prose (Fiction & Non-Fiction)
  - Submit as a .doc or .docx file
  - Works should be a maximum of 2500 words; please double-space your work

- The subject line of your email should be: [Surname] [Category] Submission (e.g. Angelou Poetry Submission).
- In the body of your email, please include:
  - o Your name
  - Contact information
  - A brief biography (50-100 words)

- Multiple submissions are permitted; each writer can submit up to 3 times. Please write a separate email for each submitted work.
- Capital City Press cannot guarantee we will provide feedback for every submission.
