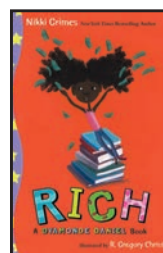
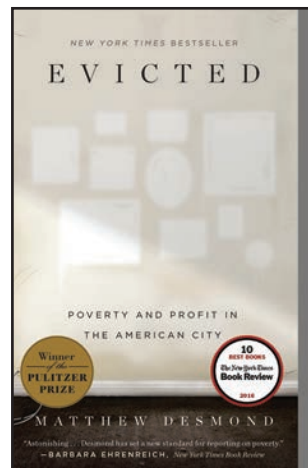


SPARKING BRAVE CONVERSATIONS ABOUT HOUSING
