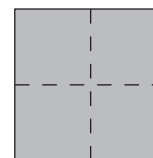

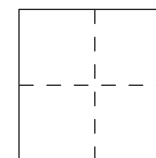


### How to make a Fortune Teller

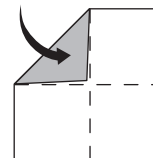
Fold in half and unfold.  
Repeat in the other direction.



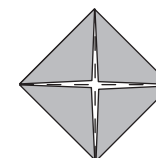
Flip the paper over.  
The side with the design should face the table.



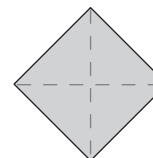
Fold the corners to the middle.



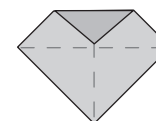
This is what you should see.



Flip the paper over.



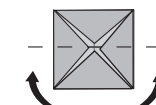
Fold the corners to the middle again.
