What will happen with Summer Challenge 2020?

Summer Challenge is still planned to occur May 1, 2020 through July 31, 2020. The brochure and log to promote the Summer Challenge were revised after our May and June programs were suspended. The new brochure focuses on July programs and includes social distancing activities that kids can do from home. Once school reopens, the revised log will be distributed to students through our partnership with CCSD. Roll-outs on how Summer Challenge works will be filmed and posted on Voyager when the library re-opens in order to help train staff.

Steve Spangler was going to provide a STEAM staff training in April. Is that still occurring?

Due to procedures of creating safer social distances and the uncertainty of being able to involve students from CCSD, the training has been suspended. Youth Services Administration is evaluating other opportunities for STEAM staff training with Steve Spangler such as a virtual conference or a separate in-person training scheduled for a later date.

UPDATE: What's happening with early voting in June?

It was previously reported that the Library District was planning to keep commitments with the election department and implement social distancing to conduct voting. Due to the COVID-19 situation the election department subsequently made the decision to change the voting format to all-mail for the primary election. Therefore, space is no longer needed by the election department at any library location for in-person voting.
