


Setting up Email Alerts for Searches using Blogtrottr in Internet Explorer or Firefox

Do a **search** in the catalog. Then click on the **RSS icon** at the top right of the search results.







A new screen will open that should look similar to this if you're using the **Internet Explorer**. Copy the URL (website address) from the address bar.


