

EXPERIMENT 8: Dish Soap Putty



Create your own putty using homemade items

STEPS:

1. Mix the dish soap and cornstarch together as best as you can for about 10 seconds. Once it becomes difficult to stir, get your hands in there!
2. Work the putty until all of the ingredients in the bowl are combined thoroughly.

TIP: because dish soap formulas can vary, it's ok if you need to add a little more. If the putty is entirely too dry, add a tiny bit more dish soap to it. Or, if the putty is too runny, add a tiny bit more corn starch to it. After adding more of either ingredient, mix the putty by hand for a few moments.

This putty is quick to make, but it doesn't last that long. You do not need to store it in a container. Simply play with it for awhile and clean up the silly putty when you're done.



MATERIALS NEEDED

- 1.5 tablespoons of dish soap
- 2 tablespoons of cornstarch
