



## What is the Vinyl Cutter?

The vinyl cutter is used to take a vector graphic created on a computer and cut the outline into a sheet of vinyl. Depending on the vinyl you can either heat press the design onto a shirt or stick the design onto a surface such as a wall, window, etc.

## Preparing the Vinyl Cutter

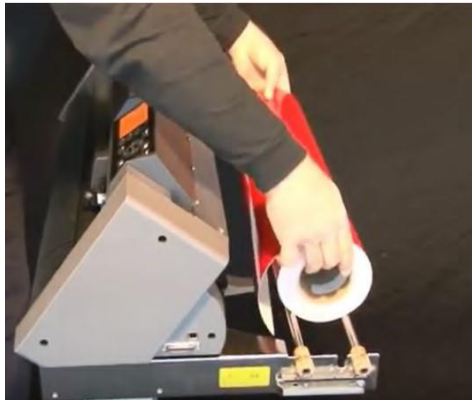
1. Turn the machine on using the power button located on the left side.



2. Unlock the lever down to load the vinyl.



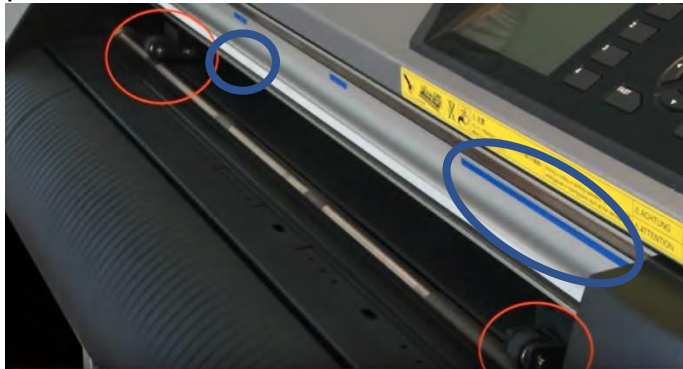
3. Rest the roll of vinyl on the rails



4. Adjust the stoppers as necessary. The stoppers should be right against the vinyl on both sides



5. Insert the vinyl through the feeder and adjust the rollers to line up with the edges of the vinyl. Each roller should be lined up with one of the blue lines above them.

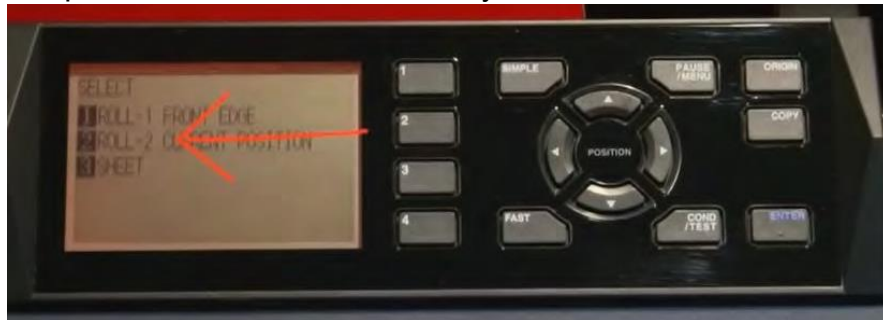


6. Lock the vinyl in place



## Machine Interface

1. Select Option #2 to calibrate the Vinyl Cutter



2. Press Number 2 to select it



3. Wait until you see READY on the screen



4. Hold down the blue ENTER button and if you're using Heat Transfer Vinyl, Press 1 and if you're using Sign Vinyl, Press 2



5. You're ready to use the computer to input your design!
