

Frisco Action Board Information

Application Process:

Applications will be available for during application periods- which vary depending on need. Applicants must be in grades 9-12 to be eligible for consideration. Submitting an application will not guarantee a spot. Full instructions will be on the application.

Service Hour Opportunities:

VolunTEENs will be credited service hours for time spent volunteering during scheduled shifts.

Frisco Action Board tasks include:

- Sorting recently returned items or shelf-reading.
- Cleaning toys used in Story Time classes or in the imaginative play areas for children.
- Straightening the library's public areas.
- Assisting with a class or event.
- Preparing crafts or assembling packets to be distributed during classes or events or as prizes.
- Other duties that help support library classes and services.

Commonly Asked Questions:

I need service hours in a short amount of time. Can I bypass the application process?

No, all new volunTEENs must follow the application process as described on the VolunTEEN Corps web page.

I missed the application window for this session. Can I still apply?

Applications for the Frisco Action Board are only accepted during the posted application windows.

I used to volunteer at the Library. Can I bypass the application process and join again?

No, all returning volunTEENs must follow the application process as described on the VolunTEEN Corps web page.

I am not in 9th grade yet, can I still apply for the Frisco Action Board?

Students entering 9th grade are eligible to apply for the summer session leading to the fall semester of their 9th grade school year.

Can my group volunteer together?

No, we cannot accommodate groups due to the nature of the tasks assigned.

I have court-ordered community service. Can I volunteer at the Library?

Unfortunately the Library is not able to accommodate court-ordered volunteer requirements at this time.
