

ArtStart Headpiece Directions

1. Unroll the long shiny piece of paper so that the shiny side faces up. Either tape it to your workspace or use something to hold down the ends.
2. Use a black marker to make a wavy line across the top long edge of the shiny piece of paper.
3. Cut along the black line on the shiny piece of paper.
4. Now that you have cut off the top wavy part, flip the paper over so that the shiny side is away from you and either tape it to your workspace or use something to hold down the ends.
5. Find the long (10-12 inches) skinny piece of paper. Next, find the center of the long sheet that you cut the wave onto. Use a glue stick and glue the skinny piece to the center of the wavy piece.
6. Make sure that the glued piece is nice and flat on the wavy piece.
7. Find the yellow paper with the outline of your bee on it. Cut the bee out.
8. Find the small shiny piece of paper with the bees wings on it. Cut out the bees wings.
9. Glue the white side of the bee wings onto the yellow part of the bee wings.
10. At this time take a black marker and color in the bee's antenna, an eye, mouth, stinger(tail end) and black stripes on to the bee.
11. Next find the glittery (Mylar) piece of paper. The clear sparkly side is removable from the white paper side. (You may need assistance separating the pieces.) Once you have removed the white paper side place the sticky (Mylar) side over your entire bee. Rub out any of the air bubbles out. Now cut around the outside of the bee, cutting away any excess Mylar.
12. Next find a small rectangle of black paper, if you don't find it cut a strip off the edge of your flower sheet. It should be about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide and about 2 inches long. Fold the piece in half (it is now about 1 inch long by $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide.)
13. Glue one side of the paper you just folded and glue it to the wavy piece of paper with the fold towards the bottom. Add glue to the top side of the piece you just glued down and glue the bee to the top side of the folded piece of paper.
14. Next find the small white square paper with the flower on it. Cut the flower out. And glue near the bee.
15. Find the stack of colored paper and the paper with the 3 flowers on it. Cut out one of the flowers and trace the outline of the flower onto the stack of colored papers. Hold the stack of papers together carefully and cut the outline of the flower out through the stack of papers.
16. You will now have the printed flower that you cut out and 6 solid color flowers that you cut out.
17. Glue the printed flower towards the top center of the headpiece. Glue 3 of the solid color flowers to the right of the printed flower and 3 solid color flowers to the left.
18. Next find the tissue paper. Fold it in half and then crinkle the bottom to make it look like a flower. Either glue or tape it to the wavy headpiece. Add the long natural colored strings near the flowers, either glue or tape them down.
19. Glue or staple the ends of the headpiece together so that it fits on your head.
20. Your spring headpiece is complete.
