

CLOSED CAPTIONING INSTRUCTIONS FOR KDL VIDEOS

KDL Programs that stream on Facebook and YouTube have options for closed captioning and displaying several languages.


Note that the captions are automatically generated and are sometimes inaccurate. The [Programming Department](#) can be contacted to fix any egregious errors in the archived videos.

FACEBOOK


Turning on Captions

On a Computer

You can adjust your [video settings](#) to always show captions, when available.

- Click  in the top right.
- Select Settings & Privacy > Settings.
- Scroll down and click Videos in the left column.
- Select On to turn on captions for Facebook videos, when available.
- Your caption settings will only apply to videos you watch on a computer.

On an iOS device

- Go to your device's home screen.
- Tap  Settings.
- Tap General > Accessibility > Subtitles & Captioning.
- Tap next to Closed Captions + SDH to turn on captions for videos, when available.

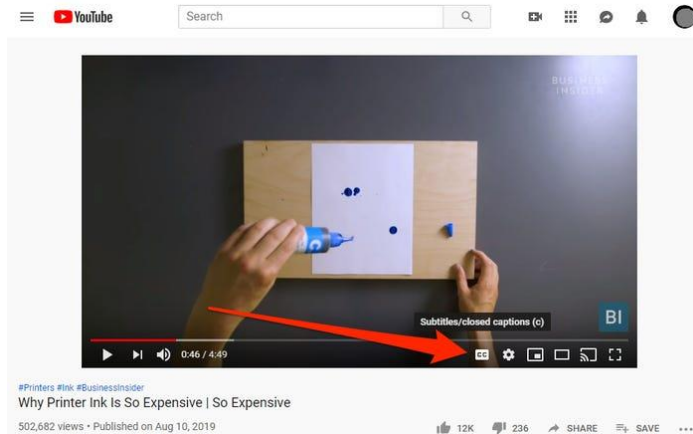

Turning on Captions

On a Computer

- You can turn on subtitles by clicking the CC icon at the bottom of a YouTube video. A red line will appear under the icon when closed captions have been enabled.

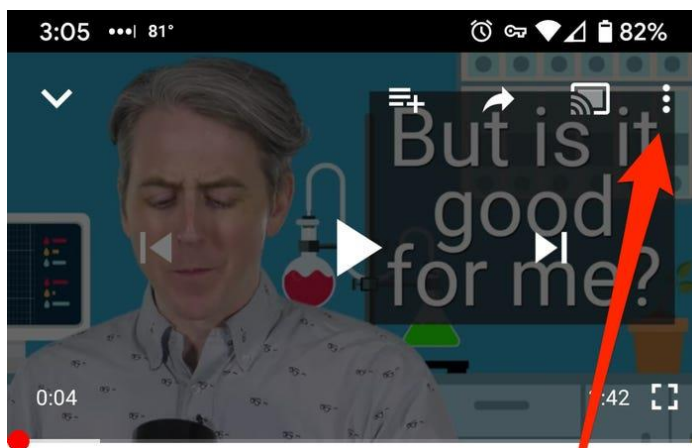


- You can also adjust caption settings by clicking the gear icon. If subtitles are available for a video, a choice of generated captions and other formats will be available here.

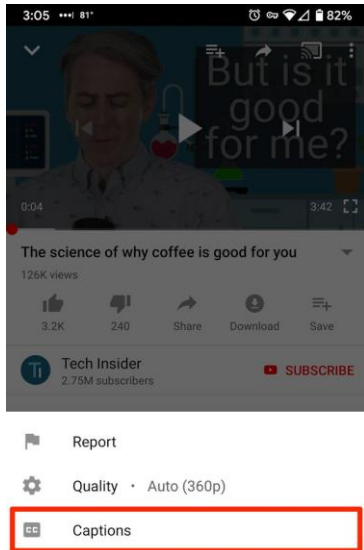

On the YouTube App

- Tap the three-dot menu in the upper right corner.



- Tap the CC icon, or Captions, in the menu.



- Select the type of captioning you prefer.

Language Options

- Choose different caption languages by clicking the captions icon on a video. If the language isn't listed, you can select the option for auto-translated captions, which are translated using Google Translate.
- Click the settings icon at the bottom of the video screen.
- Click Subtitles/CC.
- Click Auto-translate.
- Select a language.
