### **CAMANO ISLAND LIBRARY STAFF ENTRANCE CURBING SAFETY ISSUE**

#### **1. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS 10.29.20**

**Q:** Sales Tax: Please explain your policy. On my last job I paid sales tax on my materials but did not charge sales tax on my invoices. It appears from the bid form that you want me to charge sales tax.

**A:** Sno-Isle Libraries pays state sales tax on anything that is taxable. In this case, we will be paying tax on materials and on labor, so please include tax in the entire bid cost.

**Q:** It appears that the awarded contractor will be working on a time and materials basis and you want the bid to list all of the specific costs that will be associated with this project. Furthermore, you want 'high level detail' of ALL cost and 'NO MONIES WILL BE PAID FOR ITEMS OMITTED'. If I forget to list a job cost in the bid, let's say the cost of the rebar, then after I am awarded the job, you will not pay me for the cost of the rebar?

**A:** Due to the architectural bid set and specification being put out with this invitation to bid, our goal is to evaluate bids on lowest cost, so comprehensive pricing needs to be submitted. There is a means to request additional costs as outlined in Section 6.1.1 of the ITB: "No other monies will be paid for items omitted by the Bidder, unless requested and approved in advance in writing."

**Q:** Is there power and water available and if so, how close is it to the work to be performed?

**A:** There is a hose bib and electrical outlet to use. Bidder to verify location.
