The Auburn Avenue Research Library will host The Colored Unit: Stories of the Segregated Grady Memorial Hospital School of Nursing, 1920-1966.

This community discussion will focus on the racially segregated school of nursing, operated through Grady Memorial Hospital, from 1920 to 1966. Featuring first-hand experiences from members of the National Conclave of Grady Graduate Nurses, this conversation will examine how these African American graduates persevered through systemic racism, and sexism, celebrating their indelible impact on Grady Memorial Hospital and the nursing profession.

The Legacy of Black Nurses and Women in Medicine

Great and notable black women inspire many; yet, also contribute to greater conversations of equal representation, and access to pursuit various professions and education. The National Conclave of Grady Graduate Nurses is an illustration of how many black scholars, persevered through intersections of gender and racial systemic inequality.

This overview of essential sources highlights historical figures and professionals within the medical, health and life sciences. Some personal narratives about first blacks, women and prominent individuals in the nursing profession and practice are also included. A special inclusion of Grady Memorial Hospital, its history and immeasurable contributions to the nursing profession is also provided.

Resources include call numbers, for patrons to easily inquire and obtain resources. Auburn Avenue Research Library maintains non-circulating policies of its collection; however, patrons are able to utilize materials in-house. Suggested search terms and keywords are provided to further guide patron's research amongst Auburn Avenue Research Library and the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library catalog and digital libraries.

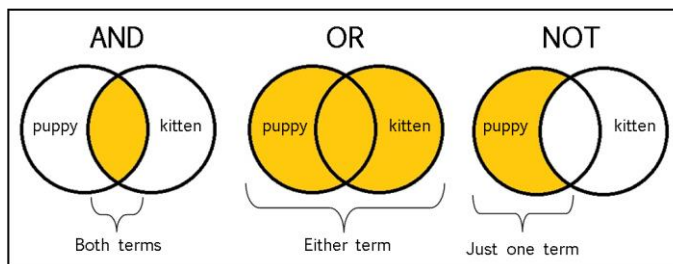
