



## **Examining Criminology and Criminal Justice in the Black Community**

The access and pursuit of equal access is a long; yet, historical telling of the black community and the community's pursuit of equality. Pipelines from academic institutions to imprisonment centers are a reality for more than the black community. The gradual understanding of how and why many in the black community are viewed as innate criminals is ultimately a conclusion of baseless academic theories of social control and conflict theory. 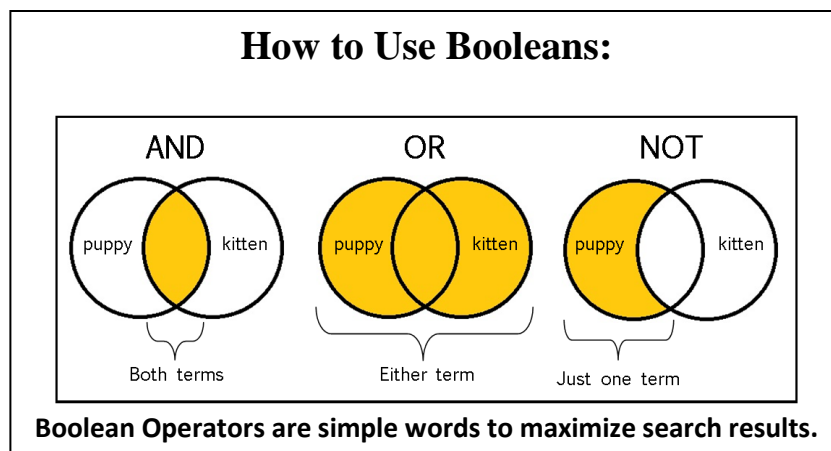
