



East African Slavery Bibliography

This listing provides essential reference and historical materials providing cover of slavery during the 1875 to the early 1930's. Specifically a special consideration of European colonization and slavery in Zambia, Kenya, the Congo region, and the lower portion of the Northern African region is provided. A special inclusion of Afro-Arab communities and cultures; with some religious practices in the Tanzanian and Malawian culture are also included.

Resources include call numbers, for patrons to easily inquire and obtain resources. 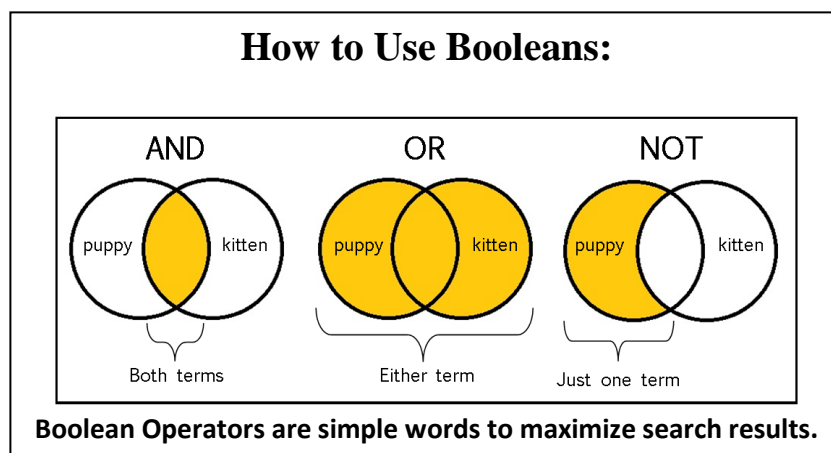
